Wally and Natasha Kulakoff - MISSION EURASIA



Wally and Natasha train people to lead and equip others to serve the next generation of national Christian leaders in 12 countries of the former Soviet Union or Eurasia, through the School Without Walls program (SWW). It is a two-year program where training takes place in 65 locations. They equip SWW students with pictorial Scriptures, New Testaments, and Bibles to minister in local churches, summer Bible camps, orphanages, prisons, and summer sports camps.
