Connect:

1) What was the best part about this last week that you want to praise God for?

Discuss:

- 1) Read Phil 1:12-18. What part of the sermon/passage did God use to stir your heart or curiosity? Why do you think he wanted you to hone in your focus on that part particularly?
- 2) Summarize how you see God's power at work through His providence, His gospel, and His People in Phil 1:12-18.
- 3) What is the promise of providence concerning our lives and struggles? (Rom 8:25) What current situation in your life comes to mind when you think about this promise?
- 4) Discuss how providence encourages boldness. Share examples from your reading or relationships of how ones boldness in Christ inspired boldness in others/yourself.
- 5) Who are the gospel advancers mentioned in Phil 1:15-18? What does the fact that both were used say about the power of the Gospel? What does it say to you?
- No one would have faulted Paul for just enduring his imprisonment. But Paul took full advantage of the hardships. How did he do this and what do you think motivated him? (1:13; 4:22; 1:14)
- 7) The Philippians partnered with Paul in a kingdom opportunity. (1:5) What kingdom opportunities have you enjoyed partnering with others in the past?
