Connect:

- 1) Share a favorite or memorable worship moment from your life.

Discuss:

- 1) Read Psalm 150. Share with each other any takeaways you had from the sermon and this passage. How do you want to respond to what God taught you here?
- 2) We learned that our worship can move from a “yawnsome to and awesome” experience by first experiencing the greatness of God’s heart, which is known by its expanse (vs1) and excellence (vs 2). What happens when we celebrate the mighty deeds of God, His rescue of rebels (us included) from slavery, wondering, and sin?
- 3) Having experienced the greatness of God’s heart, you would begin expressing the depth of your heart. What is your worship message (vs 2) and your worship means (vs 3-5)? What’s the main point of vs. 3-5 rather than getting caught up in what instruments are mentioned or not mentioned?
- 4) When we are “not feeling it” we are to engage in the longing of other’s hearts (vs. 6). We were reminded that as we gather to worship we are building a cradle for faith. What does that mean and how are you personally challenged by that thought?
