Connect:

1) Share a favorite memory from a past Easter.

Discuss:

- 1) Read Matt 21:1-17. As Pastor Bryan pointed out, for a lot of people the Easter season of Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and Easter is the time a year the church seems to make a lot of noise-about someone out of sight-that makes you uncomfortable about not being good enough. How do you relate to that statement? What does it stir in you?
- 2) How does our Lord fulfill the office of a prophet? (making plan to us... Matt 21:4-5; Zech 9:9)
- 3) What is the message our Lord as a prophet wants us to hear?
- 4) How does Christ fulfill the office of priest? Where is the proof in this passage that he is fulfilling this office? (vs 12-13; Mark 11:17; Isaiah 56:7)
- 5) He is a prophet, a priest, and who else? (Matt 21:3-9) Why is this significant to us?
- 6) He was the King of Glory. How did he show his willingness to give away glory? Why would he do such a thing?
- 7) How does your heart want to respond as you reflect on the journey your Lord took for you?
