Connect:

- 1) Seeing how this is our last Community Group this season, take a few minutes to reflect and share how you have seen God work in your life and maybe in your group this year.
- 2) Take a few minutes to lift of these things in Praise to God.

Discuss:

- 1) Read Luke 24:13-35. What we are to do with Easter is evident in how Christ ministered to his disciples after Easter. He expresses the message, mission, and motivation to communicate what we are to do with it. Describe the message in terms of a “determined love” (vv. 19-20, 25-27) and a “present love” (vv. 24, 31). What is so significant about each love in this message?
- 2) If the message of Christ’s resurrection is true and everything leading up to it and following it is true then our lives have a wonderful mission. Look at vv. 33-35 and share what we learn from the disciples as to how they went on mission.
- 3) What will motivate us to share the message and tell others with urgency and courage, “I didn’t get it, then I did!”? (vv. 32, 35)
- 4) How is it that in all the Easter festivities that our Savior can sometimes still seem remote and merely historical? There is relationship without fellowship. What can change that? (hint: Derek Redmond in the Olympics)
- 5) What is something you believe God wants you to do with Easter, which has a wonderful message, mission, and motivation?
