- 4. What do you learn about Jesus through his angry reaction to the religious leaders in this passage? What seems to be his heart for his disciples, and for his followers today?
- 5. Why is it so important to see God as, first, a loving Father who has graciously saved us through the work of his Son? How does this view of God, focused on his grace through Jesus, transform the way we seek to obey him and live holy and godly lives?
