The "Crossed out" name comes from Galatians

2:20, which says, "I have been crucified with Christ.

It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave himself for me".

When we embrace this verse, we realize that this life is not about us—it's about Christ in us. So "Crossed Out" is both the concept of "it's not about me" and also "it's about the Cross" and what Christ has done for me and wants to do through me.
