

THE RULES

Cornhole boards will be placed 27 feet apart

Players must stand parallel to their board and may not step past it.

The cornhole match will be played with 4 bags

Game is to 21 points

A coin toss will decide who goes first with the winner deciding to toss first or defer to the other team.

The team that scores last in a frame will then throw first at the next frame.

Each team will use alternate lane assignments after a team reaches 10 points. (A player will switch the side of the board they are on once 10 points are reached during the next frame)

The Cornhole match shall be played until the first team of contestants reaches (or exceeds) 21 points at the completion of a frame. The winning team does not need to win by 2 or more points.

All bags must be thrown

The Cornhole match can never end in the middle of a frame. Thus, if a team that pitches first reaches or exceeds 21 points, the game can not end until the other side is allowed to pitch all of their bags and the frame is completed.

There are no ties

If the Cornhole match is tied at 21 or more at the end of a frame, play continues until one team or the other achieves a higher score at the end of a frame and wins the match.

SCORING

In simple scoring the points are totaled at the end of each $\frac{1}{2}$ frame and the smaller score is subtracted from the larger score and the difference in points is awarded to the team scoring the most points that $\frac{1}{2}$ frame. In this scoring method only one team can score per $\frac{1}{2}$ frame.

1. Cornhole Bags In-The-Hole: are worth 3 points.
2. Cornhole Bags In-The-Count: are worth 1 point each
