HE IS RISEN!


Welcome to our Easter service that honors the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the grave, through which God transformed His sacrificial death of Good Friday into the amazing triumph over sin and death. Because Easter is the largest Christian celebration for all generations and peoples around the world, we proclaim today a message of deliverance against sin's curse of death and a message of hope that we, through faith in Christ, will receive new life in Christ according to the grace of God, a new resurrected body, and reunion with departed loved ones who have loved our Savior.

As you go home today, read and reflect on Matthew 28:1-10 and Luke 24. These passages tell the story of Jesus' resurrection. One of the implications of His resurrection is 1 Corinthians 15:50-58 where the apostle Paul affirmed, "Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?' . . . Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."
