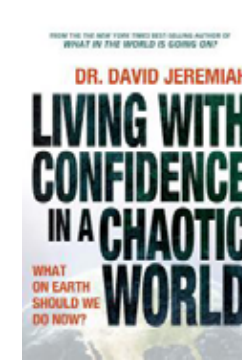
## Employment Opportunity - Administrative Assistant
