Employment Opportunity — Children's Ministry Assistant

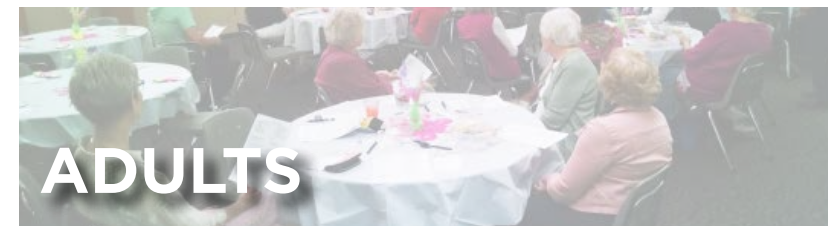
