GRACE FAMILY WORSHIP GUIDE

This sheet contains sermon reflections, a monthly song, a memory passage, and weekly Bible readings.

Sermon Text, Questions & Activities: Daily questions and an activity for children based on the past week's sermon. Young children (Level 1) can draw, while older children (Level 2) and teens/adults (Level 3) discuss questions.

Monthly Song: A song to prepare for an upcoming worship service with weekly hand motions to engage young children. Focus on adding one stanza per week with your family starting with the first stanza on the first week the song appears.

Memory Verse: A scripture passage connected to the sermon series for all ages to memorize monthly. Try to memorize one verse or so per week.

Weekly Bible Reading: Five chapters from a 3-year plan to enjoy Bible intake habits and prepare for our church's Sunday School (The Gospel Project) content. Following this plan allows families or individuals to read the entire Bible in three years. If you have children in Sunday School, this will support conversations. If you do not have children in Sunday School, it is a chronological reading plan that allows for about one chapter per day.

This Weeks Bible Chapters: Nehemiah 9,10,11,12,13

Sunday: Acts 2:36 Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

- Level 1: Draw a crown above the word "JESUS" with lots of people pointing toward it or looking up at it.
- Level 2: What does it mean for Jesus to be Lord and Christ?
- Level 3: What would it look like to not really live as if Christ were Lord?

Monday: Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"

- Level 1: Draw a heart with a crack through it.
- Level 2&3: Have you ever had a moment where you felt like you were cut to the heart by God's word? Describe it.

Tuesday: Acts 2:38 And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

- Level 1 : Draw a person turning around on a path, with an arrow showing them going a new direction, and water nearby.
- Level 2: What is repentance and what is baptism?
- Level 3: If someone asked you today, in response to the message of the gospel, "what should I do?" What would you say and why?

Wednesday: Acts 2:39 "For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself."

- Level 1 : Draw a family standing under a big umbrella labeled "God's Promise."
- Level 2: What do you think it means that God's promises are for families and not just for one person?
- Level 3: Why do Peter and Paul tie baptism to the story of Noah and the Exodus?

Thursday: Acts 2:40 And with many other words he bore witness and continued to exhort them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation."

- Level 1: Draw two paths: one straight and bright, one crooked and dark, with people choosing where to walk.
- Level 2: What are some crooked ways, common in our own generation, that a person who puts their faith should turn from?
- Level 3: What are common sins, even among professing believers, that are accepted instead of repented of? Is this okay?

Friday: Acts 2:41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

- Level 1: Draw a big group of happy people together, with water nearby and the word "CHURCH" above them.
- Level 2: Why do you think God wants people who believe in him to be part of a church family?
- Level 3: What is Luke counting and why?

Saturday: Read all of Acts 2:42-47

- Level 1: Draw a large group of people sitting around a table and eating bread together.
- Level 2&3: What questions do you have about this passage?
