This sheet contains sermon reflections, a monthly song, a memory passage, and weekly Bible readings.

Sermon Text, Questions & Activities: Daily questions and an activity for children based on the past week's sermon. Young children (Level 1) can draw, while older children (Level 2) and teens/adults (Level 3) discuss questions.

Monthly Song: A song to prepare for an upcoming worship service with weekly hand motions to engage young children. Focus on adding one stanza per week with your family starting with the first stanza on the first week the song appears.

Memory Verse: A scripture passage connected to the sermon series for all ages to memorize monthly. Try to memorize one verse or so per week.

Weekly Bible Reading: Five chapters from a 3-year plan to enjoy Bible intake habits and prepare for our church's Sunday School (The Gospel Project) content. Following this plan allows families or individuals to read the entire Bible in three years. If you have children in Sunday School, this will support conversations. If you do not have children in Sunday School, it is a chronological reading plan that allows for about one chapter per day.

This Weeks Bible Chapters: Malachi 1,2,3,4, Isaiah 7

Sunday: Acts 2:42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

- Level 1: Draw four boxes: a Bible, people eating together, bread/cup on a table, people praying.
- Level 2: If you wrote a book about 4 things you thought the church should be focused on, what would the 4 topics be?
- Level 3: Do you tend to think that the key to church health and growth are what we see here, or something else? Why?

Monday: Acts 2:43 And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.

- Level 1: Draw a crowd of people with amazed faces watching something surprising.
- Level 2&3: Should miracles be a normal experience of the church, or do you think there is a reason Luke says it was "the apostles" who performed miracles?

Tuesday: Acts 2:44 And all who believed were together and had all things in common.

- Level 1: Draw a big circle of people standing close together, sharing food and money.
- Level 2&3: Are our possessions being utilized for Jesus' community and mission?

Wednesday: Acts 2:45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.

- Level 1 : Draw someone giving a box of food or money to help another family.
- Level 2: What is an example of a "need" people have?
- Level 3: Is there anything I own that needs to be sold or repurposed to align with the Lordship of Jesus' community and mission?

Thursday: Acts 2:46 And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts,

- Level 1: Draw a big group in a church building and then a small group eating at a kitchen table.
- Level 2: Are there things you could do to make getting to church or having people in your home easier on your parents?
- Level 3: What are your barriers to being weekly present at worship, and inviting people to eat in your home?

Friday: Acts 2:47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

- Level 1: Draw more and more people joining a happy group that is singing.
- Level 2&3: Who is a non-Christian you could invite to your house with some of your Christian friends? When will you do it?

Saturday: Read all of Acts 3:1-12

- Level 1: Draw men on a ship in the sea.
- Level 2&3: What questions do you have about this text?
