 - Responsibility feeling responsible to God to carry out His ministry through you.

- \circ $\,$ Try to see her on a Sunday morning or a Wednesday night periodically.
- o Come to Special Pioneer Girl Events
- Remember her birthday with a phone call, card, and/or gift.
- Join her at Club on a Wednesday night for the whole evening or just for the activity.
- Attend a soccer game or dance recital she is involved in.
- Do activities outside of church together: (NOTE: Activities should be done with another Pal-Gal team or in a public place.)
